Bathroom Remodel Project



We are pleased to announce that the bathroom remodel project is complete. We have now an ADA Compliant bathroom with ramp from the pool area to allow wheelchair access.

The project was completed within budget, and we will start reviewing options for the sewer pipe. Contractors have provided a pipelining option estimated at \$20K but there could be similar price alternatives for a pipe replacement instead.

We will start the process of compiling different bids and as soon as we have a total of 3 different options, the board will proceed to a vote. If anyone knows a contractor that could do this type of work, please contact the office

CLARK'S LAWN FERTILIZATION/PEST CONTROL

If you have any issues with your lawn, please contact the office and Jan will notify Mr. Clark. **The quarterly schedule for fertilizing and other treatments is:**

March – June – September – December.

ALL exterior renovations, driveway additions, fences, etc. made to your property must be approved by the board of directors. You must also obtain color approval prior to painting. Please contact the office to review the color options.

COMMUNITY PARKING LOTS ON NW 53 & 54 STREETS

These parking areas are for residents ONLY.

They are not to be used to store vehicles for extended periods of time. All vehicles parked in these lots must be drivable and have a valid tag/license plate. As per the City of Tamarac code, no commercial vehicles can be parked overnight in residential zones.

Any vehicles breaking these rules will receive a courtesy notice placed on the windshield and past 72 hours will be towed at the owner's expense.



Trash and recycle guidelines.

Unfortunately, there's still a lot of people within the

community that do not follow trash and recycling rules. This affects not only the appearance of the community, but also the efforts and tax dollars spent in safe and proper disposal of our waste. Here are the waste disposal rules for our community in Tamarac:

- <u>DO RECYCLE:</u> Clean hard plastic bottles, cans, paper and flattened carboard. Please do not bag them, just put them loose in the bin with yellow lid for collection on Thursdays only.
- <u>DO NOT:</u> put any plastic bags, glass, Styrofoam, or boxes/containers with excess food residues in the recycling. Single use plastics like the ones used in disposable cutlery are not recyclable.
- Regular trash must be placed in the bin with the green lid for collection on Mondays & Thursdays.
- Big bulk trash, furniture, etc. is collected every Monday and must be placed in your front yard no earlier than Sunday evening.
